

NATIONAL DELIVERY CHAMPIONS EDUCATION GRANT 2022

FAQs

Q: What is the income criterion to be eligible for the Education Fund?

A: \$3,400 monthly gross household income or \$850 per capita if gross household income exceeds \$3,400.

Q: Where can I get the application form?

Q: How to submit the application form?

A: Application forms must be duly completed and submitted with the relevant supporting documents. Forms must reach NDCA via email to NDCA HQ by **6pm, Friday, 29th April 2022**.

Q: Can I appeal if my child's application was unsuccessful?

A: We regret that the decision of the Selection Committee is final.

Q: When will I be informed of the status of my application?

A: Applicants will be informed of the status of their application(s) via e-mail by mid of May 2022.

Q: When is the presentation ceremony?

A: The grant presentation is Wednesday, 1st June 2022, morning.

Q: Where is the presentation ceremony?

A: Applicants will be informed of the details of the grant presentation via e-mail with the status of their application(s).

Q: If I am unable to attend the presentation ceremony, can I send a proxy?

A: Attendance is **COMPULSORY**, successful applicants who absent themselves from the grant presentation are deemed to **forfeit** their grant(s).

Q: How can I ensure that NDCA has received my application form?

A: You will receive an e-mail from NDCA to confirm our receipt of your application within 3 to 5 working days upon receiving your application.
